

Chateau Tour de Luchey Bordeaux Rouge 2020



Region

The largest appellation of France and the world's greatest source of fine wine. Located in the southwest of France on the Atlantic coast, the region of Bordeaux follows the Garonne and Dordogne Rivers and their confluence as the Gironde as it flows north into the Atlantic ocean.

Producer

The Tour de Luchey is an estate of 16.31ha predominantly planted with Merlot vines on the silty banks of the Dordogne River. These vines are 40 years old and produce grapes with an old vine richness. Luchey was the king's usher, who occupied the medieval tower on the estate and monitored cargo bound for the royal courts.

It is luscious, well balanced with red fruits, good weight and ripe tannins.
