

Brouilly `L`Enfer des Balloquets` Domaine Robert Perroud 2022



Region

The vineyards of Beaujolais fall on the granite rich slopes of a hilly region between Mâcon and Lyon at the southern limit of Burgundy. The only vine variety authorised for red wines is Gamay, traditionally grown as free standing bush vines. A small amount of Chardonnay is also grown. The most favourable vineyard sites produce `villages` wines, and the 10 named `Cru` villages of Beaujolais represent the best vineyards of the region and produce the longest-lived and fullest style of Beaujolais.

Tasting Notes

The wine is named after the steep slope of burgundy on which the vineyard is situated, this 40% incline makes it impossible to machine harvest so everything is picked by hand. Undergoing Semi-carbonic Maceration with whole clusters for 12 days, giving intense fruity notes. Rich red cherries on the nose continue on the palate with notes of plum, cloves, earth and a subtle spice from 9 months ageing in oak.

Partner with roast chicken or portobello mushrooms.
