

Jackson Family Estates, Cambria Katherine's Chardonnay 2019



Producer

The winery was established by Carl Wente in 1883 on only 47 acres of land. He trained with Charles Krug of Napa Valley and together with his sons, introduced California's first varietal wine label, Sauvignon Blanc. This pioneering family have established the Livermore Valley as one of the premier wine growing areas of California and have expanded to over 2000 acres with a further 700 acres in Arroyo Seco.

Tasting Notes

Bright fruit and oak spice aromas are found on the bouquet; citrus, pineapple, white peach and apple flavors carry through the mid-palate and into the finish. The finish is crisp and bright.
