Tasting Notes

A soft and decadent Pinot Noir with aromas and flavours of cherry, sage, ripe raspberries, and earthy notes. The wine spends 10 months in both French and American oak for a rich texture and lovely notes of oak. Elegant fresh fruit is lifted by its fresh acidity and balanced by a smooth medium body and lingering finish. Enjoy this delightful Pinot Noir now or save for up to seven years.
